




We are blessed to welcome Loren Spivak to our club on Wednesday, February 25th.

NOMINATED TO BE THE NEXT U.S. AMBASSADOR TO MALAYSIA



AUSTRALIAN BY BIRTH, AMERICAN BY CHOICE

Nick Adams is an American entrepreneur, cultural thought leader, Presidential appointee, and best-selling author.

He has been a prominent and outspoken critic of illegal immigration, discriminatory practices under the guise of critical race theory, a leading voice against the perils of radical feminism, and a champion of American exceptionalism.

Nick is an Australian immigrant and naturalized American citizen. Growing up in the Sydney area, he often remembers what his parents told him after he overcame Stage IV childhood cancer given just a 5% shot at survival - "If there's a 5% chance at anything, go after it!" This advice set the course of his life: he was elected to public office at the age of nineteen, became the youngest Deputy Mayor in Australian history in Sydney at twenty-one, and went on to complete undergraduate and postgraduate degrees at the University of Sydney, one of the most elite academic institutions in the world.

In 2016, after a four-year journey through the immigration process, he founded the Foundation for Liberty and American Greatness (FLAG) - a nonprofit teaching the founding documents and American values to K-12 students. <https://www.flagusa.org/donate>

More than 1.6 million school-aged children now use FLAG's resources. Thousands of teachers and hundreds and thousands of parents have been equipped with the ability to teach civics at home and in the classroom due to Nick and FLAG's tireless work.

His work in public schools has seen him recognized by governors across the country, and he has been awarded honorary status in Arizona, Texas, Kentucky, Oklahoma, Nebraska, Arkansas, and South Carolina. In 2023, Nick was permanently enshrined in the Congressional record.

Legislative Report

Healthcare costs in California are well above the national average. The number of healthcare workers in the state increased from 1.6 million in 2016 to 2.1 million. Now close to 12% of California workers are employed in healthcare despite a stable state population. The 2023 union-backed Senate Bill 525 guaranteed minimum wage increases up to \$25 an hour for healthcare workers. Interestingly, the hospitalization costs are twice as high at the large not-for-profit hospitals favored by California policy makers than at investor-owned hospitals. The percentage of investor-owned hospitals has declined.

Emergency Medi-Cal services are available for all individuals in California. In 2016 Senate Bill 75 granted full Medi-Cal benefits to illegal aliens under age 19. In 2019 Senate Bill 104 extended coverage to young adults less than age 26. Assembly Bill 133 in 2021 further expanded eligibility to illegals age 50 and older. In 2025 Governor Newsom extended eligibility to those age 27-49. The state modified the benefit after excessive costs increased the state budget deficit. Lawmakers suspended new enrollment but not reenrollment for those age 19-49 in 2026 and added a \$30 monthly fee which will increase to \$100 in 2027.

To qualify for Medi-Cal one must earn 138% or less of the poverty line, provide proof of California residency, and documentation of identity. Federal law states that immigrants granted permanent residency must wait 5 years before they can apply for Medicaid with exceptions for refugees and asylum seekers. California has suspended the waiting period for legal residents and as noted above has extended the coverage to illegals. Immigrants cannot obtain permanent residency if they are deemed at risk of being a public charge. An individual meets the definition of a public charge if the person is institutionalized or receives cash welfare benefits. The first Trump administration broadened the rule to include receipt of Medicaid, SNAP, and housing assistance. Federal judges blocked the expanded rule, and the Biden Administration rescinded it. The current Trump administration plans to again broaden the definition of a public charge.

Medi-Cal covers five million or more than 50% of all children in California, 2.3 million disabled or seniors, and 3.4 million or about 20% of working Californians. Overall, Medi-Cal covers about one third of Californians. In 2024-2025 the total cost was \$174.6 billion of which the federal government paid 62%. The state denies seeking federal Medicaid reimbursement for the care of unqualified residents but a preliminary audit in late 2025 by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services identified \$1 billion of potentially improper federal reimbursements to California.

Economic Commentary Op-Ed

Can States financially absorb their share of formerly Federal programs?

Tightening your belt in 2026?

States' revenue growth is slowing for several years in a row, from booming revenues in prior years. Federal pandemic aid is ending and the broad tax cuts which some states adopted years ago have lowered their tax bases. Spending demands on states are rising faster than their revenues. States are grappling with medical inflation, infrastructure needs, and new financial responsibilities put on them by the federal government. The One Big Beautiful Bill Act pushes new Medicaid and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program costs onto the states. Early costs to the states could include investing in new or updated Medicaid eligibility IT systems; and also requiring the states to assume more of the costs of aid. States are reconsidering how to conform to federal tax codes. In 2026, states and cities will also be watching to see if the Supreme Court upholds or strikes down tariffs; the court heard arguments in November 2025. A National League of Cities report found 40 percent of respondents are concerned that tariffs could impact procurements; that cities are expected to spend more and potentially cancel or delay projects. Cities have also been tightening budgets in the face of tariffs. States are focusing on the FY26 budgets on improving affordability and quality of life and encouraging long-term economic growth efforts. That includes items like more college financial aid, transportation projects and better Medicaid provider reimbursement rates.

We, the citizens, will be monitoring how our County and Cities adjust to the new paradigm. Our input is needed and valuable to our government representatives. Go to your City Council meetings and County Board of Supervisors meetings to keep an active eye on what solutions they are coming up with and say something if you disagree or have a better idea.




