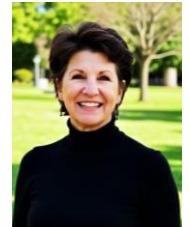

Memorial Day is a federal holiday and we celebrate and honor the women and men who died while

serving in the U.S. military. Observed on the last Monday of May, Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day with the tradition of placing flowers or other decorative displays on our loved ones US Military gravesites.

The origins of Memorial Day date back to the Civil War, which claimed the lives of some 620,000 soldiers. Devastated communities sought to honor their dead. The commemoration caught on across the USA, expanding to honor fallen soldiers from all wars, but it wasn't until 1971 that Memorial Day became a federal holiday.

The Civil War, ended in the spring of 1865, and required the establishment of the country's first national cemeteries. By the late 1860s, Americans in various towns and cities had begun holding springtime tributes, parades, memorials to these countless fallen soldiers, decorating their graves with flowers and reciting prayers.

Now is the time to show our gratitude and honor each woman and man who has served in the US Military forces. Who have lost their lives. They have all made tremendous sacrifices, and enable all of us to remain in the home of the "FREE"

When you visit a cemetery each flag that waves represents a hero, also the family's loss, the courage and commitment of service. For troops being deployed today we pray and hold them in the highest respect and honor.

#### Remembering Washington's Patriotism

"First in war, first in peace, and first in the hearts of his countrymen." These are the words that Henry "Light-Horse Harry" Lee III spoke on December 1799 in his eulogy for George Washington. In a single phrase spoken during a moment of national mourning, Lee captured Washington's generalship in the Revolutionary War, his role in shaping and forming the republic, and his enduring place in the American mind.

As we near our nation's 250th birthday, no commemoration is complete without honoring Gen. George Washington as a founder among founders. From his wartime leadership to his statesmanlike conduct as our first chief executive, he exemplified the republican virtues we hold dear as Americans. Washington is more than another name in a dull history book – he is a model for leadership in a free society. We remember him not only for what he did, but for what he can teach us about service, duty, and character in our own time. [...]

The ideas of liberty and equality were his fighting creed, the substance of a self-sacrificing patriotism. [...] As we pass our republic down to the next generation, let us teach our children, our grandchildren, and newly naturalized citizens how to think like Washington, how to emulate his virtues, and how to rise to the call of country over self.

### Legislative Report

**AB 2017 (OPPOSE)** - State holidays: Eid. (Haney) would recognize Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha as official California state holidays. It allows public schools and community colleges to close on these Muslim holy days if school districts and employee unions agree, and it requires schools to excuse student absences for observing them. The bill also lets state employees use their leave time to take these holidays off. However, the holidays would not apply to court schedules.

**AB 1973 (OPPOSE)** - Abortion: authorized procedures. (Aguilar-Curry) expands who can legally perform abortions in California and removes the rule that limited certain providers to the first trimester. Under this bill, trained and licensed health care professionals such as nurse practitioners, certified nurse-midwives, and physician assistants can perform medication and aspiration procedures at any stage of pregnancy if they are properly authorized and have completed required training.

**SB 1377 (SUPPORT)** - Immunizations: medical exemptions. (Jones) makes it easier to get a vaccine medical exemption by allowing doctors to write a simple note without state approval. It removes most oversight, so exemptions usually cannot be challenged unless there is fraud, and it protects doctors from punishment for giving them. Schools must accept these exemptions, and students cannot be treated differently or denied care because of them. Failed to pass the Senate Health Committee.

**AB 1998 (SUPPORT)** - Discrimination: sex and gender: intimate spaces. (Castillo) changes California law to define “sex” as biological male or female and requires businesses to separate intimate spaces like bathrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms based on biological sex, regardless of gender identity.

**AB 2365 (SUPPORT)** - Education-related positions: egregious misconduct: previous employment disclosures. (Sanchez) strengthens student safety by expanding the definition of “egregious misconduct” for school employees to include additional crimes such as human trafficking, child abuse or neglect, and inappropriate communication with minors. The bill also creates stronger reporting and tracking requirements, including a statewide database schools must check before hiring credentialed employees, helping prevent individuals accused of serious misconduct from moving between schools without disclosure.

**AB 1578 (OPPOSE)** - State and local officials: sexual harassment training and education: anti-hate speech training. (Jackson) would require state and local government officials to complete regular training on anti-hate speech and sexual harassment. Agencies must keep training records for at least five years and make them available to the public to ensure transparency and accountability.

- 1. Property Tax Hikes/Prop 13 Repeal:** Politicians have gutted Prop 13 and want to fully repeal it with their Split-Roll Initiative – with their ultimate goal of increasing your property taxes on your home to *today's* assessed value! If that happens, the average homeowner will end up paying \$6500-9000 more in property taxes annually.
- 2. Savings Tax:** Politicians want a new tax on your personal savings and investments.
- 3. Mileage Tax:** Politicians are proposing a 6-cents per mile tax costing an average of \$900 per driver per year!
- 4. Sales Tax Hike:** We are tracking over 250 local sales tax hikes and now state politicians are looking a statewide sales tax hike. Soon every city will be at 10-11% sales tax rate for every item you purchase.
- 5. Healthcare Tax:** Politicians propose to double California state taxes to fund government-run healthcare – costing average of \$16k per household per year.
- 6. Utility Tax:** Politicians want to impose massive "flat rate charges" on all utility bills - charging you no matter how much energy you use.
- 7. Gas Tax:** The gas tax is set to automatically increase July 1. You currently pay \$1200 a year in car and gas taxes.
- 8. Exit Tax:** And if you finally decide to move from California because of these costly taxes, state politicians want to force you to pay an exit tax for up to 10 years after you leave
